Benefits of Cognitive Skills Training

*Ninety percent of my students that need help with reading skills, also need help in improving their **cognitive skill function**. For example, some students need to strengthen sensory-motor integration skills. Some need to strengthen working memory, or selected, divided, and sustained attention. **Overall general processing speed is a skill I work upon often with students.** Deficiencies in these areas can adversely affect reading, but also impede a student’s ability to quickly process math operations, take notes in class, or do well on tests. Through a series of drills that include beat, rhythm, timing, visualization and synchronization, improvement can be seen within the very first session. Many parents look for help by obtaining academic tutoring in school subject material. Sometimes that is precisely what a student requires. However, more often than not, underdeveloped underlying cognitive skills are the problem. The drills are fun. I think my students enjoy our time together because it feels more like they are working with a coach, and the drills are just that...drills. Students begin to enjoy the fun and the challenge, and engage quickly.*

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Strengthening Skills and The Emphasis on Success

Daily emphasis on success is crucial to developing a student's drive and motivation. It comes early too, and can be experienced within the very first session together. I will quickly be able to determine your student's ability to distinguish between sounds (aural discrimination), and corrections are made quickly.

The following is a basic example. A student may look at the letter **e** and vocally produce /a/, the "phonetic sound" most often heard for the letter **a**. These subtle inconsistencies cause a problem with decoding ability.

Strengthening these foundational skills ensures the success every reader needs to achieve reading fluency, and as a result, full comprehension.

Students begin to "take control" as their awareness and comfort levels increase. They are soon

recognizing their own errors that were previously often ignored. The feeling of success begins to take root. They begin to look ahead to the joy of struggle free reading and the benefits that go along with it.

Benefits of One-on-One Tutoring

In today's world, thankfully, we have many choices and options available to us in almost every area of our lives. Computer based technology has advanced in the area of education and supplemental tools, such as on-line learning.

However, findings indicate these methods are unequivocally **no replacement for human one-on-one interaction**. The benefits of working in private sessions are almost immeasurable.
